Psalm 119

The longest chapter in the Bible praises the word of God. It is an alphabetic acrostic poem—the verses of each stanza begin with the same letter of the Hebrew alphabet. The author is possibly an Israelite priest who has returned from the seventy years of Babylonian exile. As a Psalm, it stands alone in length, form, and type. It is intended to be read rather than sung. While most of its lines are addressed to God and mingles prayers with professions of devotion to God's law, it is also intended for heavenly instruction. It is a model for devotion to God's word.

Here are some notable benefits of devotion to God's word:

*"Your word I have treasured in my heart,
 That I may not sin against You" (v. 11).*

*"So I will have an answer for him who reproaches me,
 For I trust in Your word" (v. 42).*

*"Your commandments make me wiser than my enemies,
 For they are ever mine" (v. 98).*

"I have more insight than all my teachers, For Your testimonies are

*"Your word is a lamp to my feet
 And a light to my path" (v. 105).*

*"Those who love Your law have great peace,
 And nothing cause them to stumble" (v. 165).*

The word of God guards us against sin and guides us in a life filled with joy and peace. Join the psalmist in devotion to God's word. Read it. Meditate upon it. Live it.
