Assembling Together

COVID concerns are on the rise, again. We are walking the line between being socially responsible and continuing to live life. We are asking which activities are essential and which are optional. Even if something is essential, we question whether it is safe.

Assembling together as God's church is essential. God desires for His people to meet together to worship him. *"When you come together as the church"* and similar words are repeated five times in Paul's instructions about eating the Lord's Supper together with the church (1Cor. 11:17, 18, 20, 33, 34). Another quintessential characteristic of God's people is giving. The apostle instructs Christians to give when assembled together on the first day of the week (1Cor. 16:1-3). In addition, we must come together in order to fulfill our "one another" assignments such as eating the Lord's Supper together (1Cor. 11:33) and *"speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs"* (Eph. 5:19). The assembly is a great time to greet one another (1 Cor. 16:20).

If you are sick with contagious symptoms—fever, cough, body aches, sore throat... please stay home until you are well again. If you are at a higher risk because of pre-existing health conditions, please take appropriate precautions.

However, if you are a Christian in relatively good health, please join your spiritual family for worship and Bible study. It may be hard to get out when we've gotten comfortable watching online from the comfort of our homes. Nevertheless, remember that worshiping together is essential to your relationship with God the Father and his family of believers. God expects us to assemble in person to worship Him together and to encourage each other.
