Here are a few things to remember about Jesus' return:

- 1. No one knows exactly when Jesus will return. He will arrive like a thief (Mt. 24:36, 43; 2Pet. 3:10). We must be ready and alert.
- 2. His return will be witnessed and heard by everyone (Mt. 24:30; 1Th. 4:16).
- The dead in Christ will be raised to eternal life (1Cor. 15:52; 1Th. 4:16).
- 4. The living in Christ "will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air" (1Th. 4:17).
- 5. The "Christians" who are not ready will be assigned a place with the hypocrites and unbelieving (Mt. 24:50-51; 7:21).
- 6. Anyone whose name is not found in the book of life will be thrown into hell (Rev. 20:15; Mt. 25:46).
- 7. The physical realm will be completely destroyed (2Pet. 3:10).

Therefore...

If you believe Jesus is the Savior from God but have never died to your sin with Christ, you should obey the gospel asap.

If you obeyed the gospel but have not been producing its fruit, you need to repent and renew your walk in the light of Jesus Christ sooner rather than later.
