How Gullible Are We?

A freshman at Eagle Rock Junior High won first prize at the greater Idaho Falls Science Fair, April 26, 1997. He was attempting to show how conditioned we have become to alarmist practicing junk science and spreading fear of everything in our environment. In his project he urged people to sign a petition demanding strict or total elimination of the chemical "dihydrogen monoxide."

And for plenty of good reasons, since it:

- It can cause excessive sweating and vomiting.
- It is a major component in acid rain.
- It can cause severe burns in its gaseous state.
- · Accidental inhalation of this chemical can kill you.
- It decreases effectiveness of automobile brakes.
- It has been found in tumors of terminal cancer patients.
