"The Debate That Wasn't"

It was somewhere around the year, 1840. Dr. Chester Bullard had been traveling all over Virginia preaching the gospel and baptizing hundreds into Christ. He had found his way out of denominationalism only a few years earlier and he was anxious to share the simple teaching of Jesus with all who would listen.

The Methodists became quite agitated over Bullard's preaching and selected T.J. Stone to represent them in debate on the "Acts Of Baptism." The day before the scheduled debate, Bullard set out on horseback for the appointed place and just happened to run into Stone who was riding in the same direction. The two engaged in theological conversation and the subject finally moved to the debate. Dr. Bullard "picked up" on some things Stone said, and with probing questions, discovered that Stone had changed his belief on the subject of baptism. During Stone's research for the debate he discovered that "sprinkling" was not a biblical mode of baptism and he was struggling within himself as to what he should do. Bullard finally said, "You had better let me baptize you tomorrow instead of debating." Stone replied, "If it were not for two or three things in the way, I would."

One of the greatest things in the way happened to be Stone's wife. That night Bullard, Stone and his wife discussed the Scriptures for hours. The next day a large crowd assembled for the debate but Bullard announced there would be no debate. Instead he would preach that morning and Stone would preach in the afternoon. When Bullard finished his discourse, the audience was surprised to see Mr. and Mrs. Stone present themselves for baptism.
