## Preconceived Ideas

It is impossible to read God's word without preconceived ideas. We all have biases which stem from education, experiences, economics, culture, race, age, and more. All these factors taint our interpretations of the Bible. They may cause us to see what we want to see or to ignore what contradicts our personal beliefs.

Being aware of these hinderances to arriving at truth is a good first step. A second step might be to have some of the following beliefs:

- The Bible is God's inspired word (2Tim. 3:16).
- The Bible is the standard for right and wrong (Dt. 12:32; Prov. 30:6; Rev. 22:18-19).
- The Bible is always right.
- The Bible is the complete revelation of God's will for humanity (2Pet. 1:3; Jude 1:3).
- The Bible can be understood correctly (Eph. 3:4).
- The Bible reveals the best way to live (Ps. 119:105).
- Interpretation of the Bible comes through human effort, not inspiration (1Tim. 4:15; 2Tim. 2:15).
