Repentance

Judas felt remorse after betraying Jesus (Mt. 27:3). However, he did not repent in the way that leads to salvation (2Cor. 7:10). Scripture describes him as a thief who was influenced by Satan (Jn. 12:6; 13:7). He tried to make things right with men by returning the betrayal money, but he never sought God's forgiveness (Mt. 27:3).

Judas wanted to avoid the consequences to his sin against Jesus: humiliation of being labeled a traitor, guilt for betraying innocent blood, living with the anger and frustration of Jesus not being the king who restored political, economic, and military dominance.

Arrogance can lead us to beliefs and actions which contradict God's will. It's hard for arrogant people to humble themselves and admit being wrong. It takes courage for us to acknowledge selfishness and hardheartedness.

Most people do not commit suicide as Judas did. Yet, they refuse to humble themselves, admit wrong doing, and change behaviors. This is unfortunate because God is willing to forgive if we humbly repent (1 Jn. 1:9). When James wrote to Christians, he encouraged them to be quick to hear, slow to speak, and slow to anger. He is talking about the way Christians receive God's word when it opposes one's own desires. He admonished Christians to receive the word of God with a humble heart (Jas. 1:19, 21). True followers of Jesus humbly confess sin and renew their commitment to righteousness. Truth-seekers repent and align themselves with the word of God.
