Faith

The book of Hebrews defines faith as the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen (Heb. 11:1). The writer proceeds to illustrate faith in action. He repeatedly describes examples of men and women trusting and relying upon God. Faith moves these people to obey the word of God without reservation.

Faith is also our defense against abandoning our relationship with God. The forces of evil work to turn us away from God (Eph. 6:16). Trials, catastrophes, ridicule, and losses are not accidental... *"Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour"* (1 Pet. 5:8).

When job security is up in the air, a child of God remembers that he is valuable to God the Father (Mt. 6:26-30). When one's health is bad, Christians pray (Jas. 5:15). When waiting for Jesus to return lingers, faith-filled believers recall that the promise of heaven is for the servants whom the Master finds alert and ready (Mt. 24:42; 25:13).

Initial faith comes from hearing the word of Christ (Rom. 10:17). Faith continues to grow through tests, trials, and researching God's word (Rom. 5:1-5). As it grows, we will continue to seek the city whose architect and builder is God (Heb. 11:10). Let's commit ourselves to nurturing our faith so that we will inherit eternal life.
