God's View of Sin

What's a really bad sin? Murder? Adultery?
Stealing? People tend to categorize sins as BIG and
little. They like to justify little sins—the ones that
don't have immediate consequences if any at all.
Most people think that as long as you don't seriously
hurt someone else, whatever you do is "okay."
Certain actions that used to be wrong are now
regarded as old-fashioned, cultural, or superstitions.
Several evils that once were big taboos are no
longer considered wrong.

Some people look at the commandments of God
and wonder why God makes such a big deal. For
example, eating a fruit is not a big deal. There is
nothing wrong with the fruit which Eve ate. She
considered it good... *"When the woman saw that
the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight
to the eyes, and that the tree was desirable to make
one wise..."* (Gen. 3:6).

The world believes nudity is a cultural issue. It
considers sex before marriage to be a wise test of
compatibility. It proposes that accepting immorality
is a "lifestyle choice" and a mark of enlightenment.
The modern person often views God as an
overbearing parent who enjoys limiting freedom and
fun.

Whatever the world may think, disobeying God's will
is big. It is worthy of death (Gen. 3:3; Rom. 6:23).
Christians share God's view of right and wrong.
Right is obeying God's commandments. Wrong is
disobeying them. Obedience leads to eternal life.
