Sinning Seriously?

Sinning is a serious problem. Jesus' precious blood does not help the person who continues to practice sin... "Little children, make sure no one deceives you; the one who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous; the one who practices sin is of the devil; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, to destroy the works of the devil" (1 Jn. 3:7-8).

Make sure no one deceives you. Sinning carries huge consequences. For example, the serpent denied the costs of eating the forbidden fruit telling Eve, "You surely will not die" (Gen. 3:4)!

Deceptive voices emphasize the pleasure of immorality and justify it saying that God wants us to be happy. God does want us to be happy but only within the boundaries of His righteousness.

Remember what God says about immorality: "Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals, nor thieves, not the covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, will inherit the kingdom of God" (1 Cor. 6:9-10).

Christian disciples are in league with Jesus who is destroying sin. Take sinning seriously. Hate the deeds of darkness and live in the Light. This is Jesus' invitation: "But he who practices the truth comes to the Light, so that his deeds may be manifested as having been wrought in God" (Jn. 3:21).
