“Qualified”

Give thanks to the Father, who has **qualified** us to share in the inheritance of the saints in Light (Col. 1:12).

Qualified is the translation of a Greek word meaning “to make sufficient, render fit.” It is found in the New Testament in only one other passage— 2 Cor. 3:6.

Our sins had disqualified us for the holy inheritance (Rom. 3:23; 6:23). One might say that we were out of the race and hopeless to win (Eph. 2:1-3). The average American had more of a chance of living in the White House, working in outer space, or winning Olympic gold than we had of receiving eternal life.

Can you envision the joy of being chosen to be the President of the United States? Can you imagine the adrenaline rush off working in outer space? Can you picture the excitement of representing your country in the Olympics?

We don't have to pretend what it feels like to be qualified to live with God. It is a reality through faith in Jesus Christ. There's no trophy on the shelf nor plaque on the wall, but your name is recorded in heaven... “rejoice that your names are recorded in heaven” (Lk. 10:20) and give thanks to your Father.
