Get Started

"I don't know where to begin..." and statements like it are common for those of us who are overwhelmed by busy days. In other words, we have so much to do that we can't decide where to start.

In a similar way, we can be paralyzed spiritually. Sometimes, God's word seems so difficult and complicated that we simply don't know what to do first. Other times, it seems that we are so far from what God wants us to be that any effort seems futile.

A sure way to overcome this hesitation is to concentrate on one or two of the most essential traits. Jesus says that love is the most important of God's commandments (Mt. 22:36-40).

The apostle Paul confirms the significance of love when he writes: *And if I give all my possessions to feed the poor, and if I deliver my body to be burned, but not have love, it profits me nothing* (1Cor. 13:3).

The apostle John also emphasized the importance of love toward God and brother: *...And this commandment we have from Him, that the one who loves God should love his brother also* (1Jn. 4:20-21).

On the recommendation of Jesus and His apostles, let's make love our starting point. It is sure to get us moving in the right direction and to provide us with the motivation we'll need to do all that Jesus commanded.
