## The Religious Majority

The religious majority (status quo) makes me more than just a little nervous. To be honest, they scare me. Their so-called "religion" involves too many man-made traditions and doctrines.

*See to it that no takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the basic principles of this world rather than on Christ (Colossians 2:8).*

In Jesus' day, it was the religious majority who should have known the truth about Jesus—and lead others to Jesus. Ironically, it was the religious majority who rejected Jesus and led others astray. They had reached the point that they were more concerned about their man-made religion and traditions than they were about God and God's will (Matthew 15:1-9). Does history repeat itself?

Will the majority of people ultimately be saved?

Jesus said, *"Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it"* (Matthew 7:13-14).

Will everyone who claims to be a Christian be saved?

Jesus continues by saying, *"Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven"* (Matthew 7:21).

Matthew 7:21 seems to be saying that some who consider themselves to be Christians will NOT enter heaven. That's the reason I consider this to be the scariest verse in the entire Bible. Many of today's so-called "religious" people are NOT saved! They may *GO to church* every week—but they are just as lost as those who have no religion.

Please forgive me if I come across as "holier than thou" or as "judgmental." That is not my intention. I am a sinner of the worst kind. I am totally dependent upon God's mercy and grace. I desire to have a saving relationship with God through Jesus—NOT through some man-made religion. I wish the same for you.
