The Resurrection

But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared. ² And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, ³ but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. ⁴While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men suddenly stood near them in gleaming clothing; ⁵ and as the women were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them, "Why are you seeking the living One among the dead? ⁶He is not here, but He has risen. Remember how He spoke to you while He was still in Galilee, ⁷ saying that the Son of Man must be handed over to sinful men, and be crucified, and on the third day rise from the dead." ⁸ And they remembered His words, ⁹ and returned from the tomb and reported all these things to the eleven, and to all the rest. ¹⁰ Now these women were Mary Magdalene, Joanna, and Mary the mother of James; also the other women with them were telling these things to the apostles. ¹¹ But these words appeared to them as nonsense, and they would not believe the women. ¹² Nevertheless, Peter got up and ran to the tomb; and when he stooped and looked in, he saw the linen wrappings only; and he went away to his home, marveling at what had happened (Luke 24:1-12 NASB).

Resurrection

How do you picture the resurrection? An opportunity to exact revenge on enemies? A second chance to do things the right way? Will you return with superpowers (Mt. 14:2)? Are you afraid that you will be zombie?

The Bible describes the resurrection of believers in the Lord Jesus Christ as a desirable reward.

Those who believe in Jesus have the assurance of being raised from the dead: *For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who have fallen asleep in Jesus* (1 Th. 4:14).

Believers in Christ will be raised in heavenly splendor: For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will all be changed. For this perishable must put on the imperishable, and this mortal must put on immortality (1 Cor. 15:52b-53), and "They will hunger no longer, nor thirst anymore; nor will the sun beat down on them, nor any heat; for the Lamb in the center of the throne will be their shepherd, and will guide them to springs of the water of life; and God will wipe every tear from their eyes" (Rev. 7:16-17).

The believers in the Son of God will rest from their labors and serve in God's throne room: *For the one who has entered His rest has himself also rested from his works, as God did from His* (Heb. 4:10), and *"For this reason, they are before the throne of God; and they serve Him day and night in His temple; and He who sits on the throne will spread His tabernacle over them"* (Rev. 7:15).

Don't be afraid. Believe Jesus: *"Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life"* (Jn. 5:24).
