Please consider the following ideas as you fill out your "Interests Survey."

1. Your view determines your actions. If you believe that chocolate pie as the best kind of pie, you will choose it over all other flavors of pie. If you view yourself as important and gifted by God, you are likely to volunteer, participate, and seek out ways to serve your family in Christ.
2. Every believer who worships with the Northside congregation has a God-given gift and an important role in the well-being of the local church (Rom. 12; 1 Cor. 12; 1 Pet. 4:10-11). The members of your physical body work together for the well-being of your whole body. The church is the body of Christ which has many members working together in mutual support and strength.
3. Jesus came to earth to serve (Mt. 20:28; Phil. 2:5-8). He sets the example for all believers to follow.
4. Jesus expects every believer to follow His example of service (Mt. 20:26; 23:11; Mk. 9:35; Jn. 13:14; 1 Jn. 3:16-17).
5. Whether we serve one another or not has eternal implications (Mt. 25:31-46). Christians who serve the hungry, the naked, the imprisoned, and the sick believers will receive eternal life. Christians who do not serve the basic needs of others "*will go away into eternal punishment*" (Mt. 25:46).
6. When we view ourselves like Jesus does, we will seek ways to serve Christ and His body of believers.
7. The "Interests Survey" is a tool for helping us evaluate our gifts, abilities, and interests. It is also a guide for our shepherds in equipping the Northside saints for the work of service (Eph. 4:12).
