# Peacemakers

"Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God" (Mt. 5:9).

Let's seek to be peacemakers. Let's mediate conflicts. Let's sooth tensions. Let's calm arguments. Let's resolve disagreements.

Jesus is a peacemaker. He removes hostilities between every nation, race, people, and culture (Eph. 2:13-16). Being the children of God, our calling to be peacemakers. Here are two things we can do to be peacemakers.
