- 2. Every believer who worships with the Northside congregation has a God-given gift and an important role in the well-being of the local church (Rom. 12; 1 Cor. 12; 1 Pet. 4:10-11). The members of your physical body work together for the well-being of your whole body. The church is the body of Christ which has many members working together in mutual support and strength.
