# **Spiritual Airbnb**

Many people are looking for a church that has inspiring worship. Others need a congregation that loves flawed people. A large, active youth group is a must have for some. Others are seeking strong social programs—daycare, food pantry, clothing giveaways, addiction counselling, and more.

While these things are helpful and a New Testament church might have them, they don't seem to be at the top of Jesus' list. While Jesus did give to the poor and help the sick, his main purpose was to proclaim God's plan of salvation for humanity (Lk. 4:43). He came to seek and save the lost (Lk. 19:10). Jesus established spiritual kingdom. His goals are faith, repentance, and obedience to God's righteousness. He desires to transform our character (Gal. 5:22-23). The people He seeks are willing to live as aliens and foreigners to this world (1 Pet. 2:11).

What type of church are we be trying to be—one that appeals to the worldly-minded or one that serves as an Airbnb?

God is looking for people who are willing to live temporarily as strangers and aliens so that they may inherit eternal life...
