### An Optimistic God

It's hard to remain optimistic in the face of school shootings, political corruption, and a declining economy. It's hard to remain hopeful when worship has become more about entertaining people than exalting God and Christian living has become more about personal feelings than the commandments of God.

Perhaps, we are reliving the days of Noah when *"the wickedness of man was great on the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually"* (Genesis 6:5). It would be easy to agree with Jonah and run away from God's call.

Amid this evil and wickedness, God continues to be *"a gracious and compassionate God, slow to anger and abundant in loving kindness, and one who relents concerning calamity"* (Jonah 4:2). Let's not give up preaching repentance because we think the world is lost. Instead, let's preach Christ all the more because the world is hopeless without Him. God has not given up. Each sunrise demonstrates God's continued patience... *"The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance"* (2 Peter 3:9).
