The Resurrection Promise

Jesus did not want to die. He prayed: "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; yet not as I will, but as You will" (Mt. 26:39). He knew that God would raise Him from the dead. He knew that He would return to heaven, and still, He did not wish to die.

Jesus did submit to His Father's will and died a cursed death. And as promised on the third day, God raised Jesus from the dead (Mt. 28:1-7).

Now, Jesus promises to raise you from the dead. If you surrender your will, He will raise you up to eternal life, just as His Father raised Him up (Jn. 6:40).

If you are like me, you don't want to die. You don't want to stop gratifying your selfish desires, you don't want to live differently than the people who live for the here and now, you don't want to deny yourself the pleasures and lusts of the flesh, and you do not want your heart to stop beating.

God your Father knows that it's a lot to give up. That's why He makes your death worthwhile. He promises to share His glory and divine nature with you: "For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, so that by them you may become partakers of the divine nature..." (2 Peter 1:4).

In addition, He grants you an incredible inheritance: "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection Jesus Christ from the dead, to obtain an inheritance which is imperishable and undefiled and will not fade away, reserved in heaven for you (1 Peter 1:3-4).

Jesus truly is our example. He did not want to die, but He did. And God rewarded Him. Let's follow His example so that we can also receive His reward.
