"Fool"

"I pity the fool" and "crazy fool" were B.A.'s favorite expressions. B.A. stood for "bad attitude." Mr. T played this character on the popular 80's television show: "The A-Team." It was common to hear people repeat these lines in jest with each other.

However, calling someone a fool is often done with a hurtful intention. Bible believers are sometimes called fools by sceptics who deny miracles and the existence of God.

Sometimes Christians refer to one another as fools because they disagree on various biblical interpretations. Each person believes that the other one is holding the wrong interpretation and is being deceived and naive.

Jesus cautions us against using insults toward one another. Jesus forbids us to demean each other. Here's what He said: "...whoever says, 'You fool,' shall be guilty enough to go into the fiery hell" (Mt. 5:22). In the context, anger and murder are akin to this verbal abuse.

Jesus calls us to have a spirit of patience, gentleness, and forgiveness (Gal. 5:22; Col. 3:12-14; 2 Tim. 2:24-26). There are many people who have been tricked and deceived by the devil. Our task is not to go around pointing them out with insults and slurs but to lead them out by teaching the truth in love.
