## Saved or Not?

Jesus says that it is possible to think you are saved but not be (Mt. 7:21-23). Paul says that it is possible to be saved and then to fall away (Gal. 5:4). Every Christian is under attack by the devil (Eph. 6:11; 1 Pet. 5:8), by false teachers (Mt. 7:15; 1 Tim. 4:1; 1 Jn. 4:1), and by one's own desires (2 Tim. 4:3-4).

At the same time, it is possible to know that you are saved. If you are hearing and doing Jesus' word, then you are true followers of Jesus (Mt. 12:50). If you are dying to self and following Jesus, you in a saved relationship with Christ Jesus (Mk. 8:38; Mt. 10:38). If you walk in the Light, keep His commandments, practice righteousness, love the brethren, believe that Jesus is the Son of God, then you have eternal life (1 Jn. 5:13).

It is possible to be deceived into thinking you are saved. It is also possible to know with absolute certainty that you are saved. Test yourself. Look intently at God's word and answer this question: "Does my life reflect the word of God?"

Jesus wants you to have confidence in your salvation: "*If you continue in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine*" (Jn. 8:31); and "*My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me, and I give eternal life to them, and they will never perish; and no one will snatch them out of My hand*" (Jn. 10:27-28).

In this world of so many uncertainties and insecurities, you can know if you are saved. If you're not certain, do what Jesus says and become confident.
