Change of Heart

The Greek word which is generally translated “repent” means “to change one’s mind.” Since biblically man’s mind is his heart (Gen. 6:5; Acts 8:22), and heart conveys a deeper emotion than mind, some translators select the phrase “change of heart.”

The Greek word generally translated “repent” is *metanoeo*. It points to regret and sorrow, but regret and sorrow are prerequisites of *metanoeo* (2Cor. 7:10). Regret and sorrow may lead to *metanoeo* (Mt. 21:30; Mk. 14:72), but they may stop short (Mt. 27:3). *Metanoeo* has both a prerequisite and a result (Mt. 3:8; Lk. 19:8).

Thus, “repent” does not accurately translate the Holy Spirit’s meaning of the word *metanoeo*. The Spirit wants to convey more than a feeling of sorrow. He seeks to communicate the ideas of sorrow, changed thinking, and changed behavior. In other words, one cannot simply feel regret and expect heaven’s forgiveness. Nor can one say, “I’m sorry” and expect forgiveness unless he is genuinely changing his heart and as a result, his unrighteous behavior.
