Context

Words derive meaning from context. I love pizza, and I love my wife. My desire for pizza is nowhere near my desire for my wife. Loving pizza does not mean that I only eat pizza whereas loving my wife means that we are in an exclusive relationship. Therefore, the word love means two different things.

Several biblical words change meaning according to context. One example is the word faith. Depending on the context, it can mean at least five different things. Faith may denote the system of beliefs which God has revealed for all Christians to follow (Jude 3). It may signify the miraculous power which God gave to some Christians (1Corinthians 13:2). It may mean saving faith (Ephesians 2:8). There is also a dead faith (James 2:17). Finally, faith may imply personal convictions (Romans 14:2).

If we are going to understand and apply Scriptures correctly, we must consider the context of the words. If we fail to recognize the context of a word, we may misinterpret God's meaning and misapply His instructions.

Failure to consider context may leave us short of God's will or far beyond it. Context is to biblical interpretation what location is to buying property. So, when studying the Bible remember—context, context, context!
