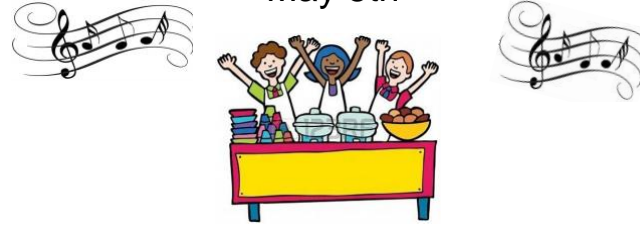

## Humble Yourself

Do you know any arrogant people? Do you know any women who think they are the center of the universe or any men who believe they are God’s gift to the world? You probably know at least one person who is always right. Being egotistical and narcissistic has become more common in recent years.

There are many Christians who believe themselves to be better than everyone else. Some even believe that God is indebted to them for their self-righteousness. Sadly, an egotistical Christian is an oxymoron and an embarrassment to Jesus, our Lord and Savior. A Christian who thinks he is the star of the show are mistaken.

This life we are living is God’s story. The first verse in the Bible sets the tone: *In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.*” We are mere background characters. God is the creator, writer, producer, director, and leading actor. God creates, speaks, loves, rules, judges, and redeems. He has all the speaking parts and action scenes. You and I are no more than extras in a film by God, for God, and about God.

When we realize that each one of us plays only a minor role in this heroic epic about the King of kings and Lord of lords, we should bow the knee and humble the heart. We are like extras in a film which appear in a frame or two. In other words, *“You are just a vapor that appears for a little while and then vanishes away”* (Jas. 4:14b). Maybe this perspective will help us to get into character:

*“Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves”* (Phil. 2:3).

*“Humble yourselves in the presence of the Lord, and He will exalt you”* (Jas. 4:10).
