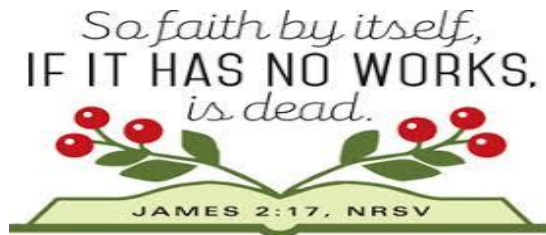

Does God Still Work Miracles?

If God continues to work miracles, what purpose do they serve? All miracles glorify God. Some miracles confirm that a message and messenger are called by God (Ex. 4:1-5; Jn. 3:2). Miracles may produce faith in God. Sometimes, the lack of a miracle also produces faith. For example, God refused to cure Paul's "thorn in the flesh" and Timothy's stomach problems (2 Cor. 12:8-9; 1 Tim. 5:23). Miracles seem to support God's purpose of revealing the gospel to save humanity from sin.

Since the gospel has been revealed, a primary purpose for miracles has come to an end (2 Pet. 1:3; Jude 1:3). The miracles which God has already done are sufficient to produce faith leading to spiritual salvation (Jn. 20:30-31).

Miracles through people were expected to end (1Cor. 13:8). When we trace the miraculous gifts of the New Testament, we find that they begin with the apostles of Jesus Christ, and end with those whom they bestowed the gifts (Acts 1:8; 2:4, 43). God working miracles through people is finished.

Inexplicable things happen. They may or may not be miraculous. God can work miracles anywhere and anytime He chooses. He is the sovereign God. However, without a revelation from Him, it's impossible for people to know if an inexplicable happening is miraculous or not. We know what God reveals, and the rest we leave to His unlimited power and love (Dt. 29:29).

While miracles are somewhat limited to certain times, places, and situations, God's power to work providentially never ceases. God is always present and operating through natural means. Joseph is an example of God's providence. Through natural events like jealous brothers and a strong work ethic, Joseph was in the right place at the right time to save many lives (Gen. 50:20). Also, Esther was born and raised to become a queen to save lives (Esther 4:14). There is every reason to believe that God continues to work through natural means to save souls.
