## You Can Do It

Jesus said, "The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak." He encouraged Peter to overcome the weakness of the flesh through prayer. After praying, Jesus successfully endured rejection and crucifixion. However, Peter slept and sinned when he denied knowing Jesus.

Peter must have learned from his failure. Later when writing to Christians experiencing the fight between the spirit and the flesh, he acknowledges the ferocity of Satan (1Pet. 5:8). But, also points out that Satan is not invincible. People can defeat Satan.

Peter endorses using faith— "*But resist him, firm in your faith...*" (1 Pet. 5:9). Paul agrees with Peter... "*taking up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one*" (Eph. 6:16).

Jesus knew something important about fighting against Satan. Peter and Paul also learned this truth—Faith is the victory! You can defeat Satan and overcome the weakness of your flesh. Instead of allowing temptation to become sin, let's kneel in prayer and hold up our faith in Jesus Christ. You can do it!
