Why Me Lord

Some of us are living the lyrics of the perfect country and western song: “Well, I was drunk the day my mom got out of prison, and I went to pick her up in the rain. But before I could get to the station in my pickup truck, she got run over by an old train.” When life sends us misfortune, we may ask, “Why me Lord?”

God’s word answers the question, “Why me.” Suffering can result in positive outcomes:

1. God’s glory... *“It was neither that this man sinned, nor his parents; but it was so that the works of God might be displayed in him”* (Jn. 9:3)
2. Proof of your faith... *“Have you considered My servant Job? For there is no one like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man, fearing God and turning away from evil”* (Job 1:8).
3. Purifying and testing your faith... *“so that the proof of your faith, being more precious than gold which is perishable, even though tested by fire, may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ”* (1Pet. 1:7).
4. Demonstrating His love for you... *“For those whom the Lord loves He disciplines”* (Heb. 12:6).
5. To know the suffering of Jesus... *“that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death”* (Phil. 3:10).
6. Following Christ’s example... *“and while being reviled, He did not revile in return; while suffering, He uttered no threats, but kept entrusting Himself to Him who judges righteously”* (1Pet. 2:23).
7. Your choices have natural consequences... *“Now when he had spent everything, a severe famine occurred in that country, and he began to be impoverished”* (Lk. 15:14).

Considering God’s revelation, we should ask, “Why not me?” Are you ready to show the world your faith and God’s glory?
