A Form of Religion

Here's a text that might open your eyes:

But realize this, that in the last days difficult times will come. For men will be lovers of self, lovers of money, boastful, arrogant, revilers, disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy, unloving, irreconcilable, malicious gossips, without self-control, brutal, haters of good, treacherous, reckless, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God; HOLDING TO A FORM OF GODLINESS, ALTHOUGH THEY HAVE DENIED ITS POWER... (2 Timothy 3:1-5).

I have emphasized the last part of this passage, although I believe every word here is commentary on the present circumstance of society. But, what about this "holding to a form of godliness?" the word, "godliness," might be translated "religion." What Paul states is this: Some people will hang on to religion, but it doesn't really mean anything to them.

WHAT DO THEY DO? They feel the necessity to "go to church," but only when it suits them. Bible reading and prayer? Hardly any time for that. Giving? Can't seem to bring themselves to a commitment. Involvement in service? "Oh, I'm busy that night."

WHY DO THEY DO IT? Guilt mostly. Somewhere nestled in the back of their minds in a Pharisaical understanding of religion as external ritual. When that particular conscience flames up, they are able to extinguish it with their "form of religion."

The folks who perhaps need Paul's warning the most will probably not even read this... too bad.
