Study God's Word

Do you make new year resolutions? Setting goals and making plans to achieve those goals is what successful people do. I hope you will jot down a few things which you want to accomplish in the coming year. I hope that those plans will be centered on growing closer to God. I have a few suggestions for you.

First, read and study God's word regularly. The word of God is a light to guide you in living a rewarding life now and receiving eternal life... "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path" (Ps. 119:105). The Bible provides commandments and principles which keep you from making bad decisions. It provides encouragement and comfort. It guides you to eternal life.

Reading it is the first step to enriching your life, improving your character, and becoming a light for others to see our loving and gracious God. You could download an app to your phone, and it will read to you. You can go old school and read it in paper and ink form. You can attend a small group Bible study during the week. You can participate in Bible study on Sunday morning.

It's best to involve yourself in several modes of study mixing private and public Bible study. It's beneficial to read from various translations and to compare them for a fuller understanding of God's meaning. It's helpful to ask questions and to be asked questions. Memorize some passages which provide comfort.
