## Love of Money

The love of money destroys lives. Just ask Achan whose love of money caused thirty-six deaths plus his life and that of his family (Josh. 7). Balaam's greed compelled him to counsel Balak, the king of Moab, how to turn the LORD against Israel (Num. 31:16). Twenty-four thousand died in the resulting plague (Num. 25:9). The love of money can cause judges and officials to distort justice (Dt. 16:19). Judas, one of the twelve personally selected by Jesus, loved money and betrayed the Son of God for thirty pieces of silver. The love of money convinced Ananias and Sapphira to lie to God (Acts 5:4). They died.

At best the love of money causes many griefs. At its worst, the love of money leads Christians away from the faith: *For the love of money is a root of all sorts of evil, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs* (1 Tim. 6:10).

Here are some indicators that you are a lover of money:

- You will compromise your moral beliefs to obtain it.
- You will disobey God to acquire it.
- You will justify lying, stealing, and cheating to gain it.
- You can't seem to get enough of it.
- You are reluctant to share it with those in need.
- Twenty dollars is too little at a restaurant, movie, grocery store, or gas pump, but when the contribution plate is in your hand, twenty dollars is too much.

Let's guard against the love of money. Learn to be content. It shuts the door on "get rich" temptations (1 Tim. 6:8, 9). Work so that you will have something to share with someone in need (Eph. 4:28). Give more than expected while trusting and glorifying God (2 Cor. 9:10-13).

Let's see money with clarity and sharpness. Let's see it as a temporary gift from God to use in blessing the lives of others. We can't take it with us when we die, but sharing it generously now stores up treasures for us in heaven, our forever home (Mt. 6:19-21).
