Responsibility

Do you take responsibility for your mistakes? From the beginning, the precedent has been to shift blame away from self and onto someone else. For example, Adam sinned and blamed his wife. In turn, Eve blamed Satan (Gen. 3:12, 13). Their children also dodged responsibility for doing evil. Cain denied responsibility for Abel's whereabouts even though he knew Abel was dead (Gen. 4:9). Aaron denied making an idol. He said that the golden calf just appeared out of the fire (Ex. 32:24). The list of shirkers goes on and on and is not limited to the Bible. Are you a shirker?

When people own up to their failures, God is forgiving. When the pagans of Nineveh acknowledged their evil and repented, God forgave them (Jon. 3:10). When Manasseh became king of Judah, *he did evil in the sight of the LORD according to the abominations of the nations whom the LORD dispossessed before the sons of Israel* (2Chron. 33:2). Later, because of the great distress, he repented and served the LORD (2Chron. 33:13-16). The Bible teaches that God forgives the person who owns up to his sins.

We live in a world that refuses to take responsibility for wrongdoing. Like immature children, everyone blames everyone else for their wrongdoing. However, God's people are not afraid to own up to their sins. We take responsibility for our evil deeds, and in return, God forgives us... *If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness* (1 Jn. 1:9).

Don't let the ways of the world creep in on you—denying wrongdoing, ignoring sins, and blaming others. We are forgiven by confessing our sins.
