Christ Our Passover

The Passover Feast marked the night in which the LORD delivered the Israelites from Egyptian slavery. The LORD passed through the land of Egypt to strike down the firstborn of man and beast. The Hebrews smeared the blood of a lamb on their doorposts as a sign to God that He should "pass over" their houses (Ex. 12). That night God delivered His people from their oppression.

At least three times, Jesus observed the Passover with the Twelve (Jn. 2:13; 6:4; 13:1). During the last Passover supper with His disciples, Jesus attached a new significance to the Passover: "...I shall never again eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God... do this in remembrance of Me" (Lk. 22:15-16,19). Like the blood of the lamb which saved the Hebrew people from death, Jesus' blood redeemed us from the power of sin and death.

The Passover feast was a solemn assembly in which the Israelites removed leaven from their homes. But Christians are to remove sin from their hearts as the apostle Paul commanded the Corinthian congregation... *Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed. Therefore let us celebrate the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth* (1Cor. 5:7-8).

When we share in the Lord's Supper, let's vow each time to remove hatred and sin from our lives while committing ourselves to a life of purity and devotion to our Savior.
