We see it every day. The mindless fascination of Americans with celebrities, be they movie stars, athletes, entertainers, successful politicians, or the fabulously wealthy. This obsession is not just a teen thing. It affects millions of adults as well.

Gloria Flora sees this as the fruit of society's admiration of affluence, attractiveness, and achievement. People are fascinated with tales of the rich and famous. They are willing to forgive or overlook or even excuse the flagrant misconduct of their idols.

This phenomenon is evident in many modern Christians. They crave a preacher that has youth, attractiveness, and worldly success. They want a church that is bigger and more wealthy than others. To them that means they themselves are more successful. Being a part of such a church is more meaningful to them than a smaller congregation with an ordinary preacher. They want a meeting place that reflects wealth, success, and bigness. They can overlook failures to abide by God's Word. They can tolerate worldliness and close their eyes to apostasy if they can just be part of the celebrity team.

Every celebrity and their adorers should be reminded of their mortality. By the grace of God, they are privileged to occupy his earth along with seven billion others who are children of the same Creator. Like every other living person and thing their days are numbered and soon they will be consumed in the dust of death. Their fame and fortune are ephemeral. Foremost, they will last a few months or years and then be gone. The once famous celebrity will be forgotten.

"Thus saith Jehovah, Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, neither let the mighty man glory in his might, let not the rich man glory in his riches; But let him that glorieth glory in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me, that I am the LORD..." (Jer. 9:23-24).
