Worship

Abraham said to his young men, "Stay here with the donkey, and I and the lad will go over there; and we will worship and return to you" (Gen. 22:5). This is the first time "worship" appears in Scripture, Abraham uses the term of his obedience in offering up Isaac as a sacrifice to God. The Bible records several sacrifices to God prior to this occasion, but this one is called "worship."

Worship originates with the command of God. He tells Abraham what to do and where to do it. Obedient worshipers receive God's pleasure. Failure to do what God commands is likely to end poorly.

Worship is an expression of faith. By faith Abraham offered up Isaac (Gen. 22:12; Heb. 11:17). Faith is doing as instructed by God because we trust God's promise and purpose. Thus, we will do it no matter what it may cost.

Worship requires an offering. Isaac was a unique and dear offering (Gen. 22:2). God does not want human sacrifice (Dt. 12:31). This was a unique occasion and circumstance. New Testament worship involves spiritual offerings such as singing, praying, money, and serving others (Heb. 13:15-16; Phil. 4:18; Rev. 8:3).

Worship is essential for our relationship with God. If we do not worship God as Abraham did, we should not expect God's presence to be with us nor His good hand to be upon us.
