Anxiety

Anxiety is a serious health concern. Research suggests that anxiety plagues millions of Americans. It is one of the factors leading to suicide and a variety of physical and mental health problems.

While most Americans do not suffer from clinical anxiety, many battle the daily pressures of life—finances, relationships, health, school, employment... Some people find relief from anxiety through recreation, exercise, and hobbies. Others turn to drugs and alcohol for freedom. These choices only provide temporary assistance. What we truly need is a permanent cure.

Jesus prescribes such a cure: *"Do not be anxious then, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'With what shall we clothe ourselves?' For all these things the Gentiles eagerly seek; But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness and all these things shall be added to you"* (Mt. 6:31-33).

When your relationship with God is your highest priority, anxiety disappears. This means that when finances are tight you give as you have prospered and find somewhere else in the budget to cut or do without. When God is your highest priority, anxiety is not a problem because prayer is at the top of your to do list (Phil. 4:6). Your day may be filled with urgent and important activities, but all of them take a backseat to talking with God. When your life is controlled by your relationship with God, anxiety has no role to play. This means that Bible study and worship assemblies take precedence over all the other important and urgent things in your life.

Those who wear the name of Christ and believe His promise will not be among the millions of Americans suffering from anxiety.
