# God In You

"That they may all be one; even as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us, so that the world may believe that You sent Me" (John 17:21).

The key to unity is the preposition "*in*." When God is *in* each one of us, real unity materializes. Love, peace, and mutual support emerge, and we function as the body of Christ (1Cor. 12).

God *in* you means that you think like the Father thinks. You view things the way He views them. His goals are your goals. His joys are your joys. You want the same things that He wants. You understand His actions and know what He is planning for the future.

Jesus makes such a connection possible through the word of God: "...for the **words** which You gave Me I have given to them; and they received them and truly understood that I came forth from You, and they believed that You sent Me" (Jn. 17:8), and "I do not ask on behalf of these alone, but for those also who believe in Me through their **word**" (Jn. 17:20).

When the word of God is *in* your mind, heart, will, and personality, you are one with the Father and the Son. Unity is only possible if God's word is ruling your life. A few principles that you use on certain occasions won't do it. Trusting in a short list of dos and don'ts won't produce it. Each of us must have the words of God in our hearts and minds.
