What To Expect When Meeting Together Resumes

It looks like we will be able to meet face to face again soon (not yet, but soon). When we do, there will be some temporary changes. Here are some of the things which may change:

- Practice social distancing. This means no kissing, hugging, shaking, or touching. We can verbally greet one another in a number of creative ways without touching.
- Families who live together can sit together in the auditorium. Otherwise, please keep six feet between you and the next person. Some rows may be blocked off or marked to help us remember and visualize 6 feet.
- Please wear a mask. We will have a few on hand, but you may be more comfortable with the one you already have. We plan to sing as a congregation while wearing masks. Early studies have shown that singing can be a high transmission event for the virus. For your protection and ours we are asking you to wear a mask.
- Sunday Morning Worship Only. We will only meet together on Sunday morning for worship. No Bible classes at this time. It will consist of 3-4 songs, opening and closing prayers, the Lord's Supper, collection, and preaching. Communion will be observed, but it might be more like "curbside pickup." There will be a localized "collection box(es)" for us to drop in our contributions. The passing of trays is temporarily suspended.
- We will continue to Live Stream our worship. Thus, anyone who might be uncomfortable or a high risk is encouraged to worship via Live Streaming.
- Our Shepherds and Deacons are meeting to discuss these and other temporary alterations to our traditions. We are striving to worship God as He commands and to comply with government regulations. Rest assured that our leadership is committed to obeying God (Acts 5:29).

Please continue to pray for an end to this virus. Let's behave like Jesus who did not disparage or utter threats when suffering but trusted in God (1Pet. 2:22, 23).
