Why We Worship

God expects us to worship Him (Jn. 4:23). God also commands us to worship Him (Heb. 10:25). When we were small children, expectations and commands were good enough. However, as adults we want good reasons for doing things.

We ought to worship God because He is worthy of worship... *“Worthy are you, our Lord and our God, to receive glory and honor and power”* (Rev. 4:11). His worthiness is derived from His nature. He is holy (Is. 6:3; 1Chr. 16:29; Ps. 99:5; Rev. 4:8). He is all-powerful, all-knowing, and omnipresent. He is the Creator of life and all things. He is the Savior.

We ought to worship God because of who He is and what He does. He gives life. He provides food and prosperity. He redeems those who believe in His Son, Jesus Christ. He forgives our sins. He offers eternal life.

We worship to show God our gratitude. We worship in response to His lovingkindness. We worship to praise His greatness. We worship to draw near to our God (Ps. 95:2).

While we receive spiritual strength from worship, we must remember that it is first and foremost a selfless act of praise, love, and appreciation to our God. True worship is God-centered, not self-centered.
