Self-Control

Would you refrain from eating one marshmallow now if you could have two marshmallows in ten minutes? Do you eat a fun size chocolate bar now or do you wait thirty minutes in order to receive a king size bar? These are actual tests given to children by psychiatrists studying selfcontrol. It is interesting to note that the children who demonstrated self-control were also more successful academically.

Success as a disciple of Jesus Christ is directly related to practicing self-control. Paul includes it in discussing the gospel with a Roman governor... But as he was discussing righteousness, self-control and the judgment to come, Felix became frightened (Acts 24:25a). Believers possess the Spirit of Christ and produce fruit which includes selfcontrol (Gal. 5:22-23). Self-control is also an indicator of spiritual maturity and an heir of eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (2 Pet. 1:5-11).

Self-control distinguishes followers of Christ from the world. Children of God govern their own speech, appetites, and emotions (1 Pet. 1:15).

Self-control can be developed in several ways. Remove temptations. Set boundaries. Reward success, and penalize failure. Forgive yourself, and learn to be content.

Growing in one's ability to restrain emotions, appetites, and language has many benefits. But, none is more powerful than receiving an everlasting award: *Everyone who competes in the games exercises self-control in all things. They then do it to receive a perishable wreath, but we an imperishable* (1 Cor. 9:25).
