Mission Impossible

Convincing people to follow Jesus seems nearly impossible. The level of selfishness practiced today is an insult to the selflessness of Jesus. Add to that a deep-seated resistance to give up sinful behaviors such as drunkenness, illicit sex, cussing, partying, and over-indulging; and you have a nearly impossible mission.

Nonetheless, I believe we can convince some people to follow Christ. In the book, **Muscle and a Shovel**, Randal is able to inspire Michael and others to obey the gospel. As the real-life story is told, one of the main factors resulting in conversion is Randal's behavior. He knows God's word and lives accordingly every day. Converts to Christ in the book are most impressed with Randal's gentle spirit and thorough knowledge of God's word. Living and knowing God's word is our best tool for opening hearts to the gospel of Jesus Christ. Walking in the Light is our best shot at opening the eyes of those trapped in the darkness of sin.

Convincing people by one's conduct is biblical. Jesus' behavior while being crucified convinced a Roman soldier (Mt. 27:54; Mk. 15:39; Lk. 23:47). Peter tells wives to win over unfaithful husbands by their chaste and respectful behavior (1 Pet. 3:1). Jesus commands his disciples to be examples of righteous living so that people will glorify God the Father (Mt. 5:16).

Look at your conduct. What is your behavior inspiring people to do?
