Endure

- For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God, you may receive what was promised (Heb. 10:36).
- Servants, be submissive to your masters with all respect, not only to those who are good and gentle, but also to those who are unreasonable. For this finds favor, if for the sake of conscience toward God a person bears up under sorrows when suffering unjustly (1Pet. 2:18, 19).

Forgive

- But Jesus was saying, "Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing" (Lk. 23:34).
- Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse (Rom. 12:14).

Love & Pray

- "But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you" (Mt. 5:44).
- But now you also, put them all aside: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and abusive speech from your mouth (Col. 3:8).

Wait patiently

• Never pay back evil for evil to anyone... Never take your own revenge, beloved, but leave room for the wrath of God, for it is written, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord (Rom. 12:17a, 19).
