# Translations

When people ask which translation is the best, I say, "The one that you will read." If you won't read it, it doesn't matter which translation you have.

All translations are the works of human beings. As such, every translation has strengths and weaknesses. Every translation has rules of interpretation which it follows. For some the goal is to be readable while others strive to be word for word translations. There are also translations done by a single religious group for the use of their members. Be especially leery of translations which are slanted in favor of a particular set of beliefs. The same goes for translations done by a single person.

There are many good English translations in print today which are the collaborative work of several individuals from various religious backgrounds. In the foreword of the translation, you should be able to find the explanation of who and how the translation came into being.

Purchase a Bible in the translation that reads smoothly for you. I recommend a study Bible which includes cross references, maps, a dictionary, a concordance, charts, introductions to each book, and commentary on select verses. Keep in mind that such aids are not inspired by God. You may also want to find one with space in the margins for your own notes. It is also a wise practice to consult a variety of translations before drawing conclusions.

There are apps which provide these tools via your favorite electronic device. While I believe that paper and ink are superior for deep Bible study, I say, "Use whichever you will read and study."
