Got Faith?

Faith saves. Jesus says, *"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life"* (Jn. 3:16).

Faith defeats temptation. Faith is the shield *"with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one"* (Eph. 6:16).

Faith is the foundation for the spiritual virtues—moral excellence, knowledge, self-control, perseverance, godliness, brotherly kindness, and love. Peter recommends adding to your faith so that you will be productive and enter the eternal kingdom (2 Pet. 1:5-11). Being fruitful and receiving God's inheritance starts with faith.

Faith is essential for a close relationship with Jesus. Paul speaks of his union with Christ in this way: *"I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me"* (Gal. 2:20).

Faith overcomes worry (Mt. 6:25-33).

Faith leads to prayer which includes *"...not My will, but Yours be done"* (Lk. 22:42).

Faith is the heart and soul of being a follower of Christ. Do you have it?

We often hear people talk about faith to move mountains. But do we have the more practical faith which saves, overcomes, defeats, yields, and trusts God?
