Equipping the Saints

Our elders want to equip you for the work of service just as Christ expects them to do (Eph. 4:11-16).

Spiritual shepherds equip the saints by example, teaching and admonishing (1Pet. 5:3; Tit. 1:9). Consequently, if you rarely attend worship assembly or Bible study, you are missing opportunities to be nurtured in the likeness and maturity of Christ. If you never pitch in on a work day, attend a meeting, or fellowship meal, you severely limit your prospects for spiritual development.
