# Be Holy

Your toothbrush is holy. It is exclusively for your mouth. You don't want others using it to brush their teeth, and you don't want it to be used for cleaning anything else, especially the toilet. Most of your possessions are set apart for your exclusive use—your car, your house, your spouse, your clothes, your yard, your income... These assets are for your restricted use. They are not for free use of others.

God is holy (Isaiah 6:3). You are His temple (1 Corinthians 6:19). Thus, you are holy to God. Why are we careful with our personal possessions but careless with God's holy name and people? We desecrate the holy God when we lie with the mouth He gave us for encouraging and blessing (James 2:10). When we text "OMG," we are defiling His sacred name (Exodus 20:7). When we gossip and slander one another, we are profaning God's holiness. When we participate in immoral behaviors, we are polluting God's holiness (1Cor. 6:17-20).

If someone used your toothbrush, you would certainly be upset and probably grossed out. Why are we not disgusted by the shaming of God's holiness? We should be outraged and appalled. As holy instruments of God, we should seek modesty and morality. Be determined to exalt God's holiness by our words and actions.
