## FISH

Jesus teaches disciples to fish for lost souls. Jesus tells Simon and Andrew: "*Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men*" (Mt. 4:19). Having been fishermen all their lives, they know everything about catching fish. They will now apply those fishing skills to bringing people to Jesus.

First, fish *fervently*. Those who are enthusiastic about fishing spend their time and money on the sport. They don't give up quickly. Even when the fish aren't biting, they will fish all night. They also enjoy talking about fishing. Likewise, when fishing for men, Jesus teaches us to be fervent—enthusiastic, devoted, and joyful.

Next, fish *intelligently*. Understand that everyone is not attracted by the same bait. Nor are people in the same place in their lives. Like some fish who swim near the water's surface, others are dwelling in the depths of darkness. Everyone needs Jesus, and we need to be aware of the differences in personalities and backgrounds. Our words need to fit the moment and be gracious (Col. 4:6).

Then, fish *skillfully*. Practice makes perfect. It takes time to learn what works and what doesn't. The more you fish for souls, the more comfortable and confident you will become. We can also learn from those who are successful fishers of men (Phil. 3:17).

Finally, fish *hopefully*. Discouragement can make it hard to go back out there. Fishing takes perseverance and patience. Editors cut out the hours of searching and probing for the fish. It seems like they catch fish every cast, but that is TV, not reality. In the real-world fishing takes effort and endurance. The joyful anticipation of saving a lost soul keeps us going back out there (Lk. 15:7).
