Family Night

Over the past year, we learned to worship God using some nontraditional methods. After a bit, we became comfortable worshipping online from home. In fact, we enjoyed it so much that we don't want to give up worshipping in our pajamas.

As things are returning to "normal," we have the opportunity to create new customs. While wearing pajamas to the public assembly is not appropriate, there are some new methods which are suitable and beneficial.

I'm envisioning a Sunday evening assembly that resembles "family night." While our children were growing up, we sought to build a strong family bond. We had fun together playing board games, dancing, bowling, and singing with our Wii. We also watched movies and made pizza from scratch. Our goal was to build the family bond.

We want to use Sunday evenings to build our Christian family bond. We will keep some of the old practices—praying, singing, and studying God's word—and also use a variety of activities to encourage and build up one another (1Th. 5:11; Heb. 3:13). Here are a few examples: prepping breakfast for Monday morning, doing origami, practicing reflection and meditation, playing board games, going for a walk, journaling, shopping for shut-ins, reading and discussing a text of God's word, prepping healthy snacks, watching a documentary, cooking on the outdoor grill, playing yard games... This will mean that the location and the time of our gathering will be fluid.
