## Traditions

Two kinds of tradition are mentioned in the New Testament—those handed down from God and those handed down from men.

Traditions handed down from God come to us through the apostles of Jesus Christ who receive the word of God through divine revelation (Acts 1:8; Jn. 16:13; 17:20; Eph. 3:5). It is these words which are required to be saved and to remain in fellowship with God (1 Cor. 11:2; 2 Th. 2:15; 3:6).

Traditions handed down from men are not binding for salvation or fellowship. In fact, when people bind traditions of men on us, they take can us out of salvation and fellowship. The apostle Paul warned the Colossian believers: *See to it that no one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deception, according to the tradition of men, according to the elementary principles of the world rather than according to Christ*" (Col. 2:8).

Jesus reprimanded the Pharisees because they required people to obey the traditions of their elders (Mt. 15:1-9; Mk. 7:1-13). Obedience to several of the traditions of the Jewish elders invalidated and neglected the commandment of God for the sake of their man-made traditions.

Let's pay attention to the teachings of the apostles (Acts 2:42). Let's require only those things which the New Testament requires. When it comes to tradition of men, we can acknowledge its value, but we should never allow traditions of men to supersede the commandments of God. Furthermore, we should not divide the body of Christ for the sake of our man-made traditions.
