Love of Money

But those who want to get rich fall into temptation and a snare and many foolish and harmful desires which plunge men into ruin and destruction. For the love of money is a root of all sorts of evil, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs (1 Timothy 6:9, 10).

The love of money brings down the wrath of God. Just ask these people—Achan, Balaam, Gehazi, Ananias and Sapphira (Joshua 7; Numbers 22; 2 Kings 5; Acts 5). The love of money leads souls away from God—a rich young ruler and Judas (Matthew 19; Luke 22).

Don't be fooled. We are not immune to the magnetism of money and material things. Instead, let's guard ourselves against it by doing the following things:

1. Learning to be content...
If we have food and covering, with these we shall be content (1 Timothy 6:8).
2. Trusting God...
Instruct those who are rich in this present world not to be conceited or to fix their hope on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who richly supplies us with all things to enjoy (1 Timothy 6:17).
3. Sharing...
Instruct them to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share (1 Timothy 6:18).
4. Pursuing spiritual possessions...
storing up for themselves the treasure of a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is life indeed (1 Timothy 6:19).
